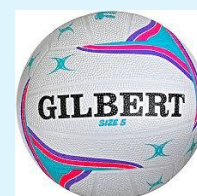
Junior Primary Awards

Well done to all of our Junior Primary award winners. They were very excited to receive their certificates at last week's assembly.



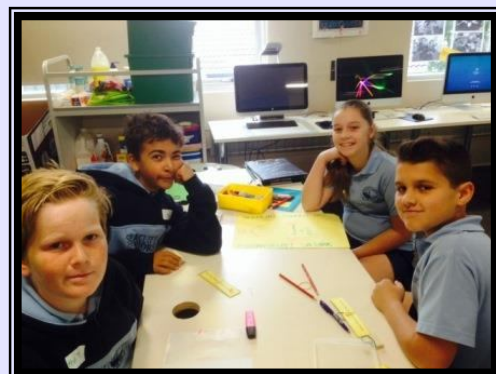
Sport Fundraiser
