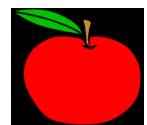

School Card Assistance is available for families eligible for financial support until the 27th November 2018. Please note that families must submit an application form **each year** to be eligible.

Applicants who apply for School Card assistance via an ED003A (Income Audit application) form are now able to apply via an online application form. The online application form is available at www.sa.gov.au under the heading **Education and Learning , Financial Support** and then **School Card scheme..**

By completing the ED003A application form online, the application form will be emailed directly to the government school(s) where the child(ren) attend, i.e. where two children attend different schools both sites will receive a copy of the application form.

Eligibility for School Card assistance is dependent upon the combined family gross income for the 2016-2017 financial year being within the following School Card income limits:

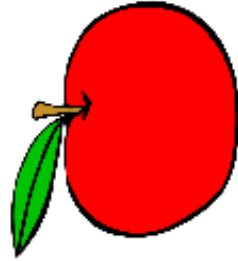

As a DECD school it is policy that we follow the Right Bite Strategy. It teaches our children to be more aware of what they eat and thus be healthier and they learn good food safety practices too - skills for life. Red category foods will only be used for special occasions such as Fund raisers.
